For a week, Milan's most iconic luxury streets will transform into an elegant stage where wine, fashion, and gastronomy meet. From October 6th to 12th, the Fashion Quadrilateral will host the 16th edition of *The harvest*, hosting the finest Italian and international wines in the exclusive setting of Milan's high-end boutiques, gourmet restaurants, and five-star hotels.



The initiative will involve Via Montenapoleone, Via Sant'Andrea, Via Verri, Via Santo Spirito, Via Gesù, Via Bagutta, and Via San Pietro all'Orto, enlivened by wine-themed art installations by designer Vincenzo Dascanio, inspired this year by the colors and visuals of freshly pressed must.

Among the main events, on Tuesday 7 October at 18 pm, in the historic setting of the Sala Castiglioni of Palazzo Bovara, the charity auction will take place *Italian Masters* curated by



Christie's Italia, the proceeds of which will be donated to Dynamo Camp, an organization committed to supporting children with serious or chronic illnesses.



On Thursday 9th October, from 19pm to 21.30pm, the boutiques will open their doors for an exclusive evening of *wine tasting* among haute couture garments and designer accessories, accompanied by labels from the most renowned Italian and international wineries.

On Friday, October 10, the Four Seasons Hotel Milano will host the eagerly awaited tasting reserved for connoisseurs, organized in collaboration with the Comitato Grandi Cru d'Italia, which will select some of the finest vintages from its members.



To complete the sensory experience, over 20 Milanese restaurants will be offering a *Harvest Menu* dedicated, with gastronomic offerings designed to enhance the pairing with the wines being tasted. Among this year's new members are names like Etereo, Finger's Garden, Gallia Lounge and Bar, Sachi Milano, and Sant Ambroeus.
